- **Feb 11, 2014:** Rule provides for consideration of S. 540 with 1 hour of general debate. Previous question shall be considered as ordered without intervening motions except motion to recommit with or without instructions. Measure will be considered read. Bill is closed to amendments.
- **Feb 11, 2014:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 85.
- **Feb 11, 2014:** Considered as privileged matter. (consideration: CR H1748-1752)
- **Feb 11, 2014:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 478.
- **Feb 11, 2014:** The previous question was ordered without objection. (consideration: CR H1752)
- **Feb 11, 2014:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by voice vote.(text: CR H1748-1749)
- **Feb 11, 2014:** On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by voice vote. (text: CR H1748-1749)
