Summary (as of May 30, 2014)

Relief for America's Main Street Lenders Act - Amends the Commodity Exchange Act, the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, the Electronic Fund Transfer Act, and the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act to exclude from the definition of financial entity, solely with respect to an interest rate swap or interest rate security-based swap, financial institutions whose total assets are \$50 billion or less.

Actions Timeline

- **Jul 7, 2014:** Referred to the Subcommittee on General Farm Commodities and Risk Management.
- **May 30, 2014:** Introduced in House
- **May 30, 2014:** Referred to the Committee on Financial Services, and in addition to the Committee on Agriculture, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
