Summary (as of Mar 12, 2013)

Liberian Refugee Immigration Fairness Act of 2013 - Adjusts to permanent resident status a qualifying Liberian national who: (1) has been continuously present in the United States between January 1, 2013, through the date of status adjustment application; or (2) is the spouse, child, or unmarried son or daughter of such an alien.

Requires adjustment applications to be filed not later than one year after the date of enactment of this Act.

- **Mar 12, 2013:** Sponsor introductory remarks on measure. (CR S1712)
- **Mar 12, 2013:** Read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary.
