Summary (as of Aug 1, 2014)

National POW/MIA Remembrance Act of 2014 - Directs the Architect of the Capitol to: (1) enter into an agreement to obtain a chair featuring the logo of the National League of POW/MIA Families, and (2) place it on the Capitol grounds in a suitable permanent location within two years after enactment of this Act.

- Aug 4, 2014: Referred to the Subcommittee on Economic Development, Public Buildings and Emergency Management.
- Aug 1, 2014: Introduced in House
- Aug 1, 2014: Referred to the House Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure.
