Summary (as of Sep 16, 2014)

Firefighter Equipment Protection Act of 2014 - Codifies a national security exemption from emissions regulations for excess personal property of the Department of Defense (DOD) that is transferred under specified DOD property transfer programs to a firefighting agency in a state or to another state agency.

Actions Timeline

- **Sep 19, 2014:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Energy and Power.
- **Sep 16, 2014:** Introduced in House
- **Sep 16, 2014:** Referred to the Committee on Armed Services, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
