- **Apr 29, 2014:** Introduced in House
- **Apr 29, 2014:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 113-426, by Mr. Cole.
- **Apr 29, 2014:** The resolution provides for 1 hour of general debate for both bills. For H.R. 4486, the resolution provides that the bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-minute rule. For H.R. 4487, the resolution makes in order only those specified amendments printed in the report. The resolution provides one motion to recommit with or without instructions during consideration of each bill.
