Summary (as of Nov 12, 2014)

Congratulates and honors Malala Yousafzai on receiving the 2014 Nobel Peace Prize for her contribution to global education equality and the promotion of peace.

States that in honoring Malala Yousafzai the House of Representatives honors those who have promoted education equality, including those individuals who continue to champion the right of all children to a peaceful education in Pakistan and elsewhere.

Emphasizes that violations of human rights in general, and the persecution of children specifically, are matters of legitimate concern to all nations.
