Summary (as of Mar 5, 2013)

Accountability in Grants Act of 2013 - Amends the Clean Air Act to prohibit the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) from awarding grants, contracts, cooperative agreements, or other financial assistance under the national research and development program for the prevention and control of air pollution for any program, project, or activity to occur outside the United States and its territories and possessions.

Actions Timeline

- **Mar 21, 2013:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Environment.
- **Mar 8, 2013:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Energy and Power.
- **Mar 5, 2013:** Introduced in House
- **Mar 5, 2013:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Science, Space, and Technology, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
