Ensuring VA Employee Accountability Act

(Sec. 2) Requires the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) to retain a copy of any reprimand or admonishment received by a VA employee in the employee's permanent record.

- **May 18, 2015:** Mr. Wenstrup moved to suspend the rules and pass the bill.
- **May 18, 2015:** Considered under suspension of the rules. (consideration: CR H3259-3260)
- **May 18, 2015:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H.R. 1038.
- **May 18, 2015:** Passed/agreed to in House: On motion to suspend the rules and pass the bill Agreed to by voice vote.(text: CR H3259)
- **May 18, 2015:** On motion to suspend the rules and pass the bill Agreed to by voice vote. (text: CR H3259)
- **May 18, 2015:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
- **Apr 16, 2015:** Subcommittee Consideration and Mark-up Session Held.
