### Summary (as of Feb 27, 2015)

#### Veterans Cemetery Benefit Correction Act

Extends the requirement that the Department of Veterans Affairs provide an outer burial receptacle for each new grave of a veteran, a veteran's spouse, or a veteran's dependent in which remains are interred in a casket in Arlington National Cemetery or in an open cemetery under the control of the the National Cemetery Administration to each such grave in an open cemetery under the control of the National Park Service.

- **Mar 23, 2015:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Federal Lands.
- **Mar 13, 2015:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Disability Assistance and Memorial Affairs.
- **Feb 27, 2015:** Introduced in House
- **Feb 27, 2015:** Referred to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs, and in addition to the Committee on Natural Resources, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
