No Healthcare Subsidies for Foreign Diplomats Act of 2015

Amends the Internal Revenue Code to deny a tax credit for the cost of health insurance premiums and health insurance cost-sharing reductions under the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act to foreign diplomats. Requires the Secretary of State to notify all foreign missions in the United States, permanent missions to the United Nations, and the United Nations Secretariat that health insurance premium tax credits and cost-sharing reductions are not available for their foreign personnel with nonimmigrant status under the Immigration and Nationality Act.

Actions Timeline

- **Mar 20, 2015:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Mar 19, 2015:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Mar 16, 2015:** Introduced in House
- **Mar 16, 2015:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committees on Energy and Commerce, and Foreign Affairs, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
