Home Visiting Extension Act

This bill amends title V (Maternal and Child Health Services) of the Social Security Act to extend through FY2015 the Maternal, Infant, and Early Childhood Home Visiting programs.

Actions Timeline

- **Mar 20, 2015:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Mar 19, 2015:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Human Resources.
- **Mar 16, 2015:** Introduced in House
- **Mar 16, 2015:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
