Summary (as of Mar 18, 2015)

Jane's Law

Amends the federal criminal code to impose a fine and/or a prison term of up to two years on any person who travels in interstate or foreign commerce to evade compliance with a court-ordered property distribution in a divorce proceeding involving more than \$5,000. Requires payment of restitution equal to the total unpaid property distribution from any person convicted of evading payment.
