Summary (as of Mar 18, 2015)

Amends the National Labor Relations Act and the Railway Labor Act to declare that nothing in those Acts shall be construed to preempt a law of any state, U.S. territory, or the District of Columbia that prohibits, criminalizes, or creates a civil cause of action for stalking, cyberstalking, or harassment.

Actions Timeline

- **Apr 29, 2015:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health, Employment, Labor, and Pensions.
- **Mar 19, 2015:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Railroads, Pipelines, and Hazardous Materials.
- **Mar 18, 2015:** Introduced in House
- **Mar 18, 2015:** Referred to the Committee on Education and the Workforce, and in addition to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
