Summary (as of Mar 24, 2015)

This bill prohibits the Department of the Interior from using any funds to make a determination on the listing of the northern long-eared bat (*myotis septentrionalis*) under the Endangered Species Act of 1973. Interior proposed in October 2013 to list the northern long-eared bat as endangered.
