Summary (as of Jun 18, 2015)

This bill amends the Federal Reserve Act to direct the Secretary of the Treasury to convene a panel of private citizens to advise and make recommendations regarding the likeness of a woman to appear on the face of \$10 federal reserve notes.

Requires the Secretary and the panel to consider and weigh input from the American people.
