## Summary (as of Jan 6, 2015)

### Firefighter Equipment Protection Act

Codifies a national security exemption from emissions regulations for excess personal property of the Department of Defense (DOD) that is transferred under specified DOD property transfer programs to a firefighting agency in a state or to another state agency.
