### Summary (as of Jul 26, 2015)

#### Veterans Entrepreneurial Transition Act of 2015 or the VET Act of 2015

This bill directs the Small Business Administration to carry out a pilot program to assess the feasibility and advisability of making grants to eligible veterans to start or acquire a qualifying business enterprise.
