Summary (as of May 1, 2015)

Medicare Independence at Home Medical Practice Demonstration Improvement Act of 2015

Amends title XVIII (Medicare) of the Social Security Act to increase from a three-year to a five-year period the length of an agreement with an independence at home medical practice under the Medicare Independence at Home Medical Practice Demonstration Program.

Actions Timeline

- **May 18, 2015:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **May 8, 2015:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **May 1, 2015:** Introduced in House
- **May 1, 2015:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
