## **Veterans Education Priority Enrollment Act**

Prohibits the Secretary of Veterans Affairs or a state approving agency from approving a program of education offered by an educational institution for purposes of an educational assistance program for veterans or members of the Selected Reserve or the Ready Reserve of the Armed Forces unless any such institution that administers a priority enrollment system allows an eligible veteran, member, or dependent to enroll in courses at the earliest possible time.

## **Actions Timeline**

- **Aug 13, 2015:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Military Personnel.
- **May 26, 2015:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Economic Opportunity.
- **May 12, 2015:** Introduced in House
- **May 12, 2015:** Referred to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs, and in addition to the Committee on Armed Services, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
