Summary (as of May 13, 2015)

Prioritizing Urgent Claims for Veterans Act

Directs the Secretary of Veterans Affairs, in processing veterans claims for compensation, to provide priority over other claimants to: (1) veterans who have attained age 70, (2) veterans who are terminally ill, and (3) veterans who have life-threatening illnesses.

Actions Timeline

- **May 26, 2015:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Disability Assistance and Memorial Affairs.
- **May 13, 2015:** Introduced in House
- **May 13, 2015:** Referred to the House Committee on Veterans' Affairs.
