Actions Timeline

- **Apr 30, 2015:** By direction of the Committee on Rules, Mr. Woodall called up H.Res. 231 for its immediate consideration. (consideration: CR H2671)
- **Apr 30, 2015:** Mrs. Watson Coleman raised a point of order against consideration of H. Res. 231 and the Chair recognized Mrs. Watson Coleman and Mr. Woodall for up to 10 minutes each on the point of order. After debate, the Chair will put the question of consideration on the resolution as the statutory means of disposing of the point of order in the following form: "Will the House now consider the resolution?"
- **Apr 30, 2015:** On question of consideration of the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 240 - 174 (Roll no. 179). (consideration: CR H2673-2674)
- **Apr 30, 2015:** Considered as privileged matter. (consideration: CR H2671-2684)
- **Apr 30, 2015:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 231.
- **Apr 30, 2015:** On ordering the previous question Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 241 - 181 (Roll no. 180). (consideration: CR H2683-2684; text: CR H2683)
- **Apr 30, 2015:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by recorded vote: 242 - 181 (Roll no. 181).(text: CR H2671-2672)
- **Apr 30, 2015:** On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by recorded vote: 242 - 181 (Roll no. 181). (text: CR H2671-2672)
