Summary (as of May 14, 2015)

Expresses support for the goals and ideals of an International Day Against Homophobia and Transphobia.

Encourages: (1) health care providers to offer culturally and clinically competent care to the lesbian, gay, bisexual, or transgender (LGBT) community; (2) schools to support the creation of gay-straight alliances to achieve safer learning environments; (3) individuals to learn about national resources for those who identify as LGBT; and (4) the federal government, states, international funding organizations, and U.S. bilateral and multilateral aid efforts to prioritize the health and human rights of LGBT people.

Actions Timeline

- **May 15, 2015:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **May 14, 2015:** Introduced in House
- **May 14, 2015:** Referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs, and in addition to the Committees on Energy and Commerce, and Education and the Workforce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
