Summary (as of May 15, 2015)

Recognizes that prevention of mother-to-child transmission of HIV is critical to stopping the spread of HIV worldwide and that the fight to eliminate pediatric HIV worldwide has been a priority for more than 13 years.

Supports providing women with HIV counseling and testing services and dramatically scaling up pediatric treatment of HIV.

Actions Timeline

- **May 22, 2015:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **May 15, 2015:** Introduced in House
- **May 15, 2015:** Referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
