Summary (as of May 21, 2015)

Expresses the sense of the House of Representatives that:

- gains made in border security in the Border Patrol's Yuma Sector and positive trends in recidivism rates are of critical importance to those living and working in the border region and to the nation;
- refusing to prosecute first time illegal border crossers will jeopardize those gains and the executive branch should remove any policy or direction to cease prosecuting first time illegal border crossers under Operation Streamline;
- the border security steps that have led to some measure of improvement on the border, such as the historical implementation of Operation Streamline, should be preserved.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 1, 2015:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Immigration and Border Security.
- **May 21, 2015:** Introduced in House
- **May 21, 2015:** Referred to the Committee on the Judiciary, and in addition to the Committee on Homeland Security, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
