## **Department of Homeland Security Appropriations Act, 2017**

Provides FY2017 appropriations to the Department of Homeland Security (DHS).

Provides appropriations for Departmental Management and Operations for:

- the Office of the Secretary and Executive Management,
- the Office of the Under Secretary for Management,
- the Office of the Chief Financial Officer,
- the Office of the Chief Information Officer,
- Analysis and Operations, and
- the Office of Inspector General.

Provides appropriations for Security, Enforcement, and Investigations for:

- U.S. Customs and Border Protection,
- U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement,
- the Transportation Security Administration,
- the U.S. Coast Guard, and
- the U.S. Secret Service.

Provides appropriations for Protection, Preparedness, Response, and Recovery for:

- the National Protection and Programs Directorate,
- the Office of Health Affairs, and
- the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA).

Provides appropriations for Research, Development, Training, and Services for:

- U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services,
- the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center,
- Science and Technology, and
- the Domestic Nuclear Detection Office.

Sets forth permissible and prohibited uses for funds provided by this and other appropriations Acts. Rescinds specified amounts previously appropriated to DHS.
