Summary (as of Jul 10, 2015)

This bill requires that health care claims submitted with ICD-9 codes (the code set currently used in health care transactions to identify diagnoses and procedures) continue to be paid during the transition from the ICD-9 code set to the ICD-10 code set.

Actions Timeline

- **Jul 21, 2015:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Jul 17, 2015:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Jul 10, 2015:** Introduced in House
- **Jul 10, 2015:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
