Summary (as of Jan 29, 2015)

Hearing Aid Assistance Tax Credit Act

Amends the Internal Revenue Code to allow a tax credit of up to \$500 in a taxable year for the purchase of a hearing aid that is authorized under the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act for commercial distribution and is intended for use by the taxpayer or a dependent of the taxpayer.
