Summary (as of Jun 17, 2015)

Sets forth the rule for consideration of the Senate amendment to the bill (H.R. 2146) to amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to allow Federal law enforcement officers, firefighters, and air traffic controllers to make penalty-free withdrawals from governmental plans after age 50.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 18, 2015:** By direction of the Committee on Rules, Mr. Sessions called up H.Res. 321 and asked for its immediate consideration. (consideration: CR H4497-4507)
- **Jun 18, 2015:** POINT OF ORDER - Ms. Slaughter raised a point of order against the provisions of H.Res. 321 because it violates the Congressional Budget Act. The Chair announced that the disposition of the point of order would be resolved by the question of consideration on the resolution. The House proceeded with 20 minutes of debate on the point of order at the end of which the Chair will put the question on consideration.
- **Jun 18, 2015:** On consideration of the resolution Agreed to by voice vote. (consideration: CR H4499)
- **Jun 18, 2015:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 321.
- **Jun 18, 2015:** The previous question was ordered without objection. (consideration: CR H4506)
- **Jun 18, 2015:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 244 - 181 (Roll no. 373).(text: CR H4497)
- **Jun 18, 2015:** On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 244 - 181 (Roll no. 373). (text: CR H4497)
- **Jun 18, 2015:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
- **Jun 17, 2015:** Introduced in House
