Summary (as of Jul 28, 2015)

Battery Storage Innovation Act

This bill amends the Energy Policy Act of 2005 to expand the categories of projects that are eligible for innovative technology loan guarantees by including a project for battery storage technologies for residential, industrial, or transportation applications.

Actions Timeline

- **Aug 18, 2015:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Energy.
- **Jul 31, 2015:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Energy and Power.
- **Jul 28, 2015:** Introduced in House
- **Jul 28, 2015:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Science, Space, and Technology, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
