Jobs Now Act of 2015

Amends the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act to direct the Department of Labor to carry out a two-year pilot program to award competitive grants to general local government units or community-based organizations to retain, employ, or train employees who provide them a public service.

Prescribes program requirements, including that:

- each unit or organization grantee give priority to the retention, employment, and training of veterans, individuals with disabilities, individuals who receive unemployment benefits, or dislocated workers; and
- Labor give priority to the award of grants to units and organizations with high unemployment, foreclosure, and poverty rates.

- **Mar 23, 2016:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Higher Education and Workforce Training.
- **Sep 17, 2015:** Introduced in House
- **Sep 17, 2015:** Referred to the House Committee on Education and the Workforce.
