Summary (as of Jul 14, 2015)

This resolution urges the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the Department of Homeland Security to explore emerging technologies that are mobile and capable of supplying high volumes of sterile, pathenogenic-free water to communities and hospitals when water systems are closed as a result of EPA-induced shutdowns, disease outbreaks, epidemics, pandemics, or natural disasters.

Actions Timeline

- **Jul 17, 2015:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Environment and the Economy.
- **Jul 15, 2015:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Water Resources and Environment.
- **Jul 14, 2015:** Introduced in House
- **Jul 14, 2015:** Referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
