Respect States' and Citizens' Rights Act of 2015

This bill amends the Controlled Substances Act to declare that federal laws, including criminal penalties, are not intended to supersede or preempt state laws that pertain to marijuana.

Actions Timeline

- **Oct 5, 2015:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Crime, Terrorism, Homeland Security, and Investigations.
- **Oct 2, 2015:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Sep 28, 2015:** Introduced in House
- **Sep 28, 2015:** Referred to the Committee on the Judiciary, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
