Summary (as of Oct 9, 2015)

Keep Your Chiropractor Act

This bill amends title XVIII (Medicare) of the Social Security Act to specify that, with respect to the use of private contracts between Medicare beneficiaries and physicians, a "physician" includes a licensed chiropractor.

Actions Timeline

- **Oct 16, 2015:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Oct 9, 2015:** Introduced in House
- **Oct 9, 2015:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
