States' Right of Refugee Refusal Act of 2015

This bill prohibits the Office of Refugee Resettlement or the federal agency administering refugee resettlement from resettling or coordinating placement of any refugee in a state whose government has communicated to the Office that the state government does not accede to such resettlement or placement.

Actions Timeline

- **Dec 4, 2015:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Immigration and Border Security.
- **Nov 30, 2015:** Sponsor introductory remarks on measure. (CR H8417)
- **Nov 17, 2015:** Introduced in House
- **Nov 17, 2015:** Referred to the House Committee on the Judiciary.
