Restoring the Partnership for County Health Care Costs Act of 2015

This bill amends titles XVI (Supplemental Security Income), XVIII (Medicare), XIX (Medicaid), and XXI (Children's Health Insurance Program) (CHIP) to allow an otherwise eligible individual who is in custody pending charges to receive SSI, Medicare, Medicaid, or CHIP benefits.

Any SSI benefits payable to such an individual: (1) must be withheld until the individual is no longer in custody; and (2) if the individual dies while in custody, shall be paid to the individual's estate.

Actions Timeline

- **Dec 11, 2015:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Dec 9, 2015:** Introduced in House
- **Dec 9, 2015:** Sponsor introductory remarks on measure. (CR E1748)
- **Dec 9, 2015:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Dec 9, 2015:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
