### **Maximizing Small Business Competition Act of 2016**

(Sec. 2) This bill amends the Small Business Act to authorize a procurement center representative to review any solicitation for a contract or task order without regard to whether:

- it is set aside for small businesses,
- one or more contract or task order awards are reserved for small businesses under a multiple award contract, or
- the solicitation would or would not result in a bundled or consolidated contract or a bundled or consolidated task order.

- **Apr 20, 2016:** Received in the Senate and Read twice and referred to the Committee on Small Business and Entrepreneurship.
- **Apr 19, 2016:** Mr. Chabot moved to suspend the rules and pass the bill.
- **Apr 19, 2016:** Considered under suspension of the rules. (consideration: CR H1833-1834)
- **Apr 19, 2016:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H.R. 4332.
- **Apr 19, 2016:** Passed/agreed to in House: On motion to suspend the rules and pass the bill Agreed to by voice vote.(text: CR H1833)
- **Apr 19, 2016:** On motion to suspend the rules and pass the bill Agreed to by voice vote. (text: CR H1833)
