Summary (as of Feb 8, 2016)

Renters Fairness and Equality Act

This bill amends the Internal Revenue Code to allow a tax deduction of all rent paid or accrued on the principal residence of a taxpayer, but denies such deduction if the assessed or appraised value of the residence exceeds \$1 million.
