Summary (as of Feb 11, 2016)

Tennessee Wilderness Act of 2016

This bill designates specified federal lands in Cherokee National Forest in Tennessee as wilderness and as additions to existing components of the National Wilderness Preservation System.

Actions Timeline

- **Feb 29, 2016:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Conservation and Forestry.
- **Feb 17, 2016:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Federal Lands.
- **Feb 11, 2016:** Introduced in House
- **Feb 11, 2016:** Referred to the Committee on Natural Resources, and in addition to the Committee on Agriculture, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
