### **Protecting Taxpayers by Recovering Improper Obamacare Subsidy Overpayments Act**

(Sec. 2) This bill amends the Internal Revenue Code to eliminate the limitation on the increase in tax imposed upon certain low-income families for advance payments of the tax credit for health insurance premium assistance that exceed the allowable amount of such credit.
