- H.R. 3455, the Gun Trafficking Prevention Act of 2015;
- H.R. 3130, the Zero Tolerance for Domestic Abusers Act;
- H.R. 3411, the Fix Gun Checks Act of 2015;
- H.R. 1217, the Public Safety and Second Amendment Rights Protection Act of 2015; and
- legislation to ban assault weapons.

Actions Timeline

- **Dec 3, 2015:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Disability Assistance and Memorial Affairs.
- **Nov 3, 2015:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Crime, Terrorism, Homeland Security, and Investigations.
- **Oct 8, 2015:** Introduced in House
- **Oct 8, 2015:** Referred to the Committee on the Judiciary, and in addition to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
