Summary (as of Apr 18, 2016)

Protection of Social Security Benefits Restoration Act

This bill amends title II (Old Age, Survivors and Disability Insurance) of the Social Security Act to prohibit the application of, and repeal authority for, administrative offsets to Social Security, railroad retirement, and black lung benefits.

Actions Timeline

- **Apr 28, 2016:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Social Security.
- **Apr 18, 2016:** Introduced in House
- **Apr 18, 2016:** Referred to the Committee on the Judiciary, and in addition to the Committee on Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
