Condemns the recent dangerous and unprofessional Russian intercepts of U.S.-flagged aircraft and vessels.

Calls on: (1) the Russian Federation to cease provocative military maneuvers that endanger U.S. and allied forces; and (2) the United States, its European allies, and the international community to pressure the Russian Federation to cease such behavior.

Reaffirms the right of the United States to operate military aircraft and vessels in international airspace and waters.

- **Jun 28, 2016:** Committee on Foreign Relations. Reported by Senator Corker without amendment and with a preamble. Without written report.
- **Jun 28, 2016:** Placed on Senate Legislative Calendar under General Orders. Calendar No. 538.
- **Jun 23, 2016:** Committee on Foreign Relations. Ordered to be reported without amendment favorably.
- **Jun 20, 2016:** Introduced in Senate
