Clarifying Congressional Intent in Providing for DC Home Rule Act of 2016

(Sec. 2) This bill repeals the Local Budget Autonomy Amendment Act of 2012 (D.C. Law 19-321) and restores previous law as though the Act had never been enacted.

(Sec. 3) The District of Columbia Home Rule Act is amended to declare that nothing in it shall be construed as creating a continuing appropriation of the General Fund of the District.

All funds provided for the District of Columbia shall be appropriated on an annual fiscal year basis through the federal appropriations process.

The District of Columbia Code is amended to declare that nothing in it shall be construed as authorizing the District of Columbia to make any change in law, regulation, or basic procedure and practice relating to the respective roles of Congress, the President, the Office of Management and Budget, and the Government Accountability Office in the preparation, review, submission, examination, authorization, and appropriation of the total budget of the District of Columbia government.

- **May 25, 2016:** Rule H. Res. 744 passed House.
- **May 25, 2016:** Considered under the provisions of rule H. Res. 744. (consideration: CR H3208-3217)
- **May 25, 2016:** The resolution provides for consideration of S. 2012 and H.R. 5233.
- **May 25, 2016:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H.R. 5233.
- **May 25, 2016:** Mr. Connolly moved to recommit with instructions to the Committee on Oversight and Government. (consideration: CR H3215; text: CR H3215)
- **May 25, 2016:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with 10 minutes of debate on the Connolly motion to recommit with instructions, pending reservation of a point of order. The instructions contained in the motion seek to report the same back to the House forthwith with an amendment to allow the District of Columbia government to use local funds to prevent and treat the Zika virus. Subsequently, the reservation of a point of order was withdrawn.
- **May 25, 2016:** The previous question on the motion to recommit with instructions was ordered without objection. (consideration: CR H3216)
- **May 25, 2016:** On motion to recommit with instructions Failed by the Yeas and Nays: 179 - 239 (Roll no. 247). (consideration: CR H3216)
- **May 25, 2016:** Passed/agreed to in House: On passage Passed by recorded vote: 240 - 179 (Roll no. 248).(consideration: CR H3208)
- **May 25, 2016:** On passage Passed by recorded vote: 240 - 179 (Roll no. 248). (consideration: CR H3208)
- **May 25, 2016:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
