Medicare Beneficiary Enrollment Improvement Act

The bill requires the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services to request recommendations from stakeholders on information included in the Welcome to Medicare package and update the information included in the package accordingly.

Actions Timeline

- **May 20, 2016:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **May 17, 2016:** Introduced in House
- **May 17, 2016:** Sponsor introductory remarks on measure. (CR E717)
- **May 17, 2016:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
