End EPA Rogue Spending Act

This bill requires the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to deposit any fees it collects into the general fund of the Treasury and prohibits the EPA from spending the fees unless the authority is provided in advance by an appropriations Act.

Actions Timeline

- **Sep 30, 2016:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Environment.
- **Jun 30, 2016:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Conservation and Forestry.
- **Jun 22, 2016:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Water Resources and Environment.
- **Jun 21, 2016:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 21, 2016:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committees on Agriculture, Transportation and Infrastructure, and Science, Space, and Technology, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
