### Summary (as of Jul 25, 2016)

### Menstrual Products for Employees Act

This bill amends the Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970 by requiring the Department of Labor to issue a rule that requires each private employer with at least 100 employees to provide free menstrual hygiene products for their employees.
