Summary (as of Sep 14, 2016)

Puerto Rico Health Insurance Fairness Act of 2016

This bill amends the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act to exempt health insurers in jurisdictions where premium subsidies and cost-sharing reductions are not available from the annual fee on health insurers. Currently, premium subsidies and cost-sharing reductions are not available in U.S. territories. The bill reduces the total amount to be collected annually from health insurers by the amount that would have been collected from those jurisdictions.

Actions Timeline

- **Sep 20, 2016:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Sep 14, 2016:** Introduced in House
- **Sep 14, 2016:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
