Summary (as of Sep 20, 2016)

Improving Cancer Treatment Education Act of 2016

This bill amends title XVIII (Medicare) of the Social Security Act to establish Medicare coverage with respect to comprehensive treatment education services for cancer patients.

In addition, the bill requires the National Institutes of Health to expand, intensify, and coordinate research on cancer symptom management improvement.

Actions Timeline

- **Sep 27, 2016:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Sep 20, 2016:** Introduced in House
- **Sep 20, 2016:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
