Apollo I Memorial Act

This bill directs the Department of the Army to construct in Arlington National Cemetery a memorial marker in honor of the three crew members of the mission that became known as the Apollo I mission who died during a launch rehearsal test on January 27, 1967, at the Kennedy Space Center.

Actions Timeline

- **Oct 19, 2016:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Readiness.
- **Oct 6, 2016:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Disability Assistance and Memorial Affairs.
- **Sep 30, 2016:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Space.
- **Sep 22, 2016:** Introduced in House
- **Sep 22, 2016:** Sponsor introductory remarks on measure. (CR E1354)
- **Sep 22, 2016:** Referred to the Committee on Armed Services, and in addition to the Committees on Veterans' Affairs, and Science, Space, and Technology, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
